Welcome riders. We are excited to create an all-new 'Motorcycle' Adventure Passport. We placed the motorcycle symbol on those stops that are kind to riders (7 total). Good surfaced roads, safe parking and not too much hiking as we know what its like to stroll around in leather. Of course the more adventurous riders or 'dual sporters' may chose to get all 13 stops, but be forewarned, those that rode to Skinners Bluff a couple of years ago know exactly what we mean. This year also includes our infamous 'Detours' (Yellow Sign) so if you see the D symbol on the passport, please note there may be more than one stop in order to get the punch.

After all the hard work and great riding, you will be eligible to win \$1,000 worth of motorcycle gear from Tennyson's Yamaha.

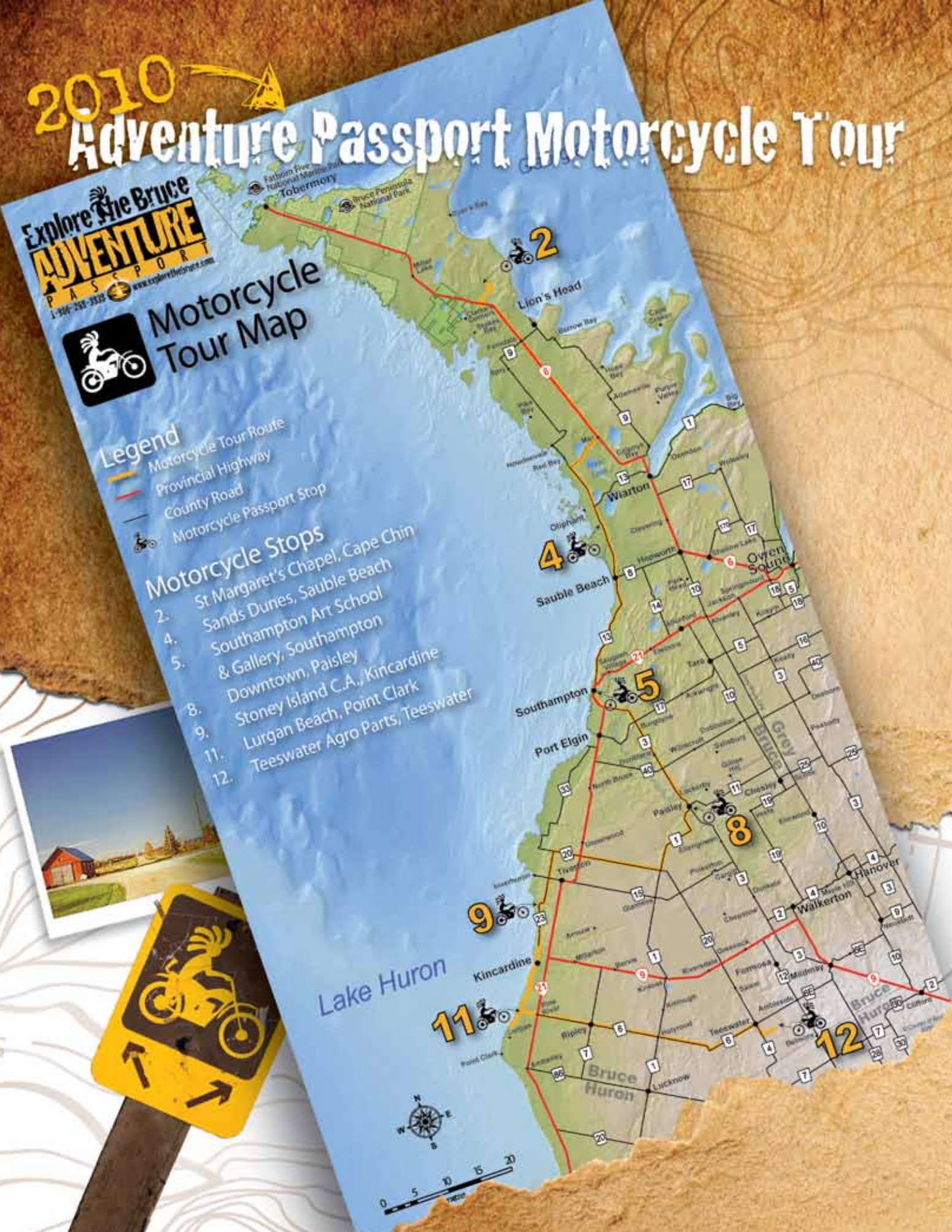

Starting Point – Teeswater Agro Parts (Passport Stop # 12)

This may change based on where you are coming from but for looping purposes we've started the tour in Teeswater as most riders are coming from south of the Bruce. Teeswater Agro Parts is located at 1421 Concession 4.

Once you get your punch, head to the Gay Lea Farm Fresh Country Store for some delicious local goodies.

Lurgan Beach (Passport Stop # 11)

From Teeswater Agro Parts, head southwest on Concession 4 to Bruce Rd 4. Turn right and go into Teeswater. Make a left on Bruce Rd 6 (Hillcrest St. W) and follow it all the way to Pine River (Hwy 21). There is a jog in the road so follow the signs carefully. Continue straight through at Hwy 21. The road becomes Concession 8. Make a left onto Lake Range Dr and then a right onto Concession 6 West. Follow this road all the way to Lake Huron to get your punch.

Stoney Island C.A. (Passport Stop # 9)

Take Concession 6 West back east to Lake Range Dr. Turn left and follow Lake Range all the way to Kincardine. Make a right onto Penetangore Row. Go past the harbour then make a right onto Lambton St. and a left onto Queen St. Follow Queen St (Bruce Road 23) to Stoney Island C.A., which is located on the left hand side. Grab your punch and head to the next stop.

Downtown, Paisley (Passport Stop # 8)

Continue north on Bruce Rd 23 through Tiverton to Bruce Rd 20. Turn right and cross Hwy 21 as you head southeast. At Bruce Rd 1, turn left and head into the Village of Paisley. The clue is located on bridge on Queen St. This is a detour stop so you can either read the clue, park your bike and walk, or read the clue then park your bike at the corner of Victoria and Alma St. to find the box.

Southampton Art School & Gallery (Passport Stop # 5)

Find your way back to Queen St. and follow it north all the way to Hwy 21. Turn right and head into Southampton. The clue is located just before the lights on your right hand side. Again, this is a detour stop. You may park your bike or ride to the box using the instructions from the clue. When in Southampton, check out all the shops and restaurants on High St. Some local favourites include Arman's Café and the Lighthouse.

Sand Dunes – Sauble Beach (Passport Stop # 4)

Find your way back to Hwy 21 (Albert St.). Turn right (north) and cross the bridge. At Bruce Rd 13, turn left. Follow it through the lights at Sauble Beach and past Sauble Falls. The box is located just north of Sauble Falls on the right hand side.

St. Margaret's Chapel – Cape Chin (Passport Stop # 2)

From the Dunes, continue north on Bruce Rd 13. At the stop sign, continue north on Bryant St. all the way to Red Bay Rd. Turn right then make a left onto Hwy 6. Make a right onto Lindsay Rd 5 and a left onto the East Rd. The church is located on the left hand side.

Congratulations, this concludes the Motorcycle Adventure Passport Tour. Depending on where you came from, you can head back to Hwy 6 and head south all the way to Hanover, which puts you back at the southern end of the County.

Be sure to send in your completed passport for a chance to win \$1,000 of motorcycle gear from Tennyson's Yamaha. Be sure to tell all your friends and come back and do it backwards.
