

2009 Adventure Passport Motorcycle Tour

Welcome riders. We are excited to create an all-new 'Motorcycle' Adventure Passport. We placed the motorcycle symbol on those stops that are kind to riders (8 listed but you only need 7 to qualify). Good surfaced roads, safe parking and not too much hiking as we know what its like to stroll around in leather. Of course the more adventurous riders or 'dual sporters' may chose to get all 13 stops, but be forewarned, those that rode to Skinners Bluff last year know exactly what we mean. This year also includes our infamous 'Detours' (Yellow Sign) so if you see the D symbol on the passport, please note there may be more than one stop in order to get the punch.

After all the hard work and great riding, you will be eligible to win \$2000 worth of his and hers FXR motorcycle gear from www.fxrracing.com.

Starting Point – Walkerton Toyota (Passport Stop # 12)

This may change based on where you are coming from but for looping purposes we've started the tour in Walkerton as most riders are coming from South of the Bruce.

If you need some suggestions on the scenic routes to Walkerton - just email or call us (1-800-268-3838) and we will help. There is a detour at this first stop...don't worry its easy...just follow the instructions on your passport. Just by chance you might end up in Mildmay to get the final punch, but you will have to read the clues first.

Holyrood (Passport Stop # 11)

From Mildmay simply take Bruce Road 6E and Bruce Road 6 west through Teeswater to beautiful downtown Holyrood. Make sure to validate your Adventure Passport at the store and get one of the Bruce's best ice-cream cones.

Tiverton (Passport Stop # 9)

Follow Bruce Road one north...make a quick right left when you hit Hwy 9 to stay on number 1. Follow up to beautiful downtown Glamis. Here you have two choices, go east on 15 to Pinkerton and stop # 10 or save that until the end and continue on to Tiverton going left on 15.

Denny's Dam (Passport Stop # 7)

Continue on 15 west from Tiverton to 23. Go right to #20 and turn left. You will see the Bruce Power visitor centre, very worthwhile stopping in to see how nuclear energy is made. Follow 20 down the hill by the main gates to Bruce Power and follow right as it turns into 33. Zig zag your way all the way to Port Elgin. Head left onto Hwy 21 or Goderich Street into downtown. Turn left onto Green Street and head down to the beach and follow Stevens Street north to where it turns into North Shore Road. Follow this all the way to High Street into Southampton and turn right. Go through downtown, past the hospital and turn left onto Carlisle Street and follow down to Denny's Dam for a small Detour and your next punch.

Saugeen Amphitheatre (Passport Stop # 6)

Follow your way back out to High Street to downtown Southampton. Make a right onto to 21 and stay on for about 3 miles to the Saugeen Amphitheatre, part of the Saugeen First Nation. There is lots of parking beside the old church and a walk into the gardens overlooking the Saugeen River will find your next punch.

Tamarac Island Inn – Stokes Bay (Passport Stop # 3)

Now, once again you have options. We gave you 8 motorcycle stops, but you only need 7 to qualify. You can loop from the Amphitheatre back down to Gilles Hill, and Pinkerton for the last 2 stops or you can keep heading north to Stokes Bay....we know you want to!! Out of the

Amphitheatre parking turn left on 21 and head back a few miles to Bruce Road 13 and head north to Sauble. Be sure to cruise the strip (Lakeshore Blvd) as it kicks you back out onto 13 at Sauble Falls. Keep going north and even when 13 goes east to Warton, keep going north on Huron Road until you get to the Red Bay Road, turn right on go out to Hwy 6. (For those gravel lovers you can keep going north past Red Bay Road all the way up to Stokes Bay). At hwy 6 go North up to Ferndale. Turn left on Bruce Road 9 to Stokes Bay Road. Go right and follow into Stokes Bay. At the Stop sign turn left and follow all the way out to Tamarac Island Inn. (Its cottagey out here so lots of little roads...just stick to the pavement). Once at the Inn, be sure to say hi to Bill Schultz, the owner and have a bite to eat.

Gillies Hill (Passport Stop #8)

From Tamarac Island, simply retrace your steps back to Ferndale. Cross Hwy 6 to Lions Head, be sure to check out the harbour. Follow 9 all the way back south to Warton. Set the bike on cruise and head south on 6, straight through at Hepworth on 10 and follow Bruce Road 10 through Tara, and two concessions before Chesley turn right onto Concession 6. Go 3 concession blocks to Beautiful downtown Gillies Hill. You will find the punch near the Cairn.

Spokeshave Antiques – Pinkerton (Passport Stop # 10)

Now, if you didn't get to this just after Holyrood, now is your chance. From Gillies Hill go south to Bruce Road 11, turn right to Paisley. In Paisley, turn left on Bruce Road 3 and follow until Bruce Road 15, go right. Pinkerton is the second small farming town, the cool Antique Store is across the bridge and around the corner on the right. If you have a giant cruiser you may want to strap on some antique furniture.

Congratulations, this concludes the Motorcycle Adventure Passport Tour. Depending on where you came from, you can head back to Bruce Road 3 and follow to signs Walkerton and it puts you right back at the beginning.

Be sure to send in your completed passport for a chance to win his and hers FXR motorcycle gear. Be sure to tell all your friends and come back and do it backwards.

Please Note

It is possible to get your entire Adventure Passport completed on a motorcycle. Be advised there will be gravel, uneven parking, and extensive hiking with the other remaining stops. For those Adventure Bike riders out there, it will be part of the fun.
